Awarded to Guards Colonel Chirva S.N. on Dec. 16th 1942. Colonel Chirva was also awarded with 2 orders of Suvorov 2nd class, order of Kutuzov 2nd class, plus 6 other orders. Very impressive set of decorations to a midrange commander. *Scarce*

First type, with soldered center medallion. Original silver nut. Awarded to Sen. Lieutenant Lapin L.P., Airborne Navy of the North Fleet. Comes with copy of the official research reply from the Central Naval archive.

Senior Lieutenant Lapin was heavily wounded in 1942, with one of his feet amputated. However, half a year later he was able to return to active duty in his regiment. More on his story in 'North Convoys: researches, recollections, documents'. *Rare* low numbered and with such history


Major-General Stankevsky Dmitry Ivanovich joined RKKA in 1922, and finished his distinguished military career as deputy commander of the 128th Rifle Corp, 28th Army. Recipient of 8 orders, including the 3 listed plus the Order of Lenin and 4 Orders of the Red Banner. All 3 of the listed orders are official duplicates, issued as replacements for the lost/stolen ones. All have the original serial numbers stamped with small digits, together with Cyrillic 'Д' for duplicate. *Extremely rare set*

Guards Lieutenant Colonel Matsievsky I.I. started his military career in 1933. By the start of WWII he was serving as asst. HQ commander of the 547th Howitzer Artillery Regiment. His successful military actions and skillful command propelled him to the position of commander of the 21st Guards Mortar Regiment, and rank of Lieutenant Colonel. Comrade Matsievsky was transferred to the reserves in August 1958. He died May 4th, 1977.

Major-General Kuznetsov Sergej Nikolaevich joined RPKA in 1926. By the end of the war, he was serving as commander of the 96th Guards rifle division. His illustrious career is clearly evident by 11 orders (!), bestowed upon him, including Suvorov 2nd Class, 2 Kutuzov 2nd Class and B.Khmelnytsky 2nd class orders. It is worth noticing that beside the 'lucky' number 777 on the order of Kutuzov, he also had Suvorov 2nd class with the number 1111. *Rare* set to a true war hero

3139 Order of Kutuzov 2nd Class with research. Type 2. Award # 2557. Screwback. 5-rivets. Original silver nut.

Comes with copies of official research from the Ministry of Defense of the Russian Federation, including award card, decrees and citations. Awarded to Colonel Volkov A.A. on Aug. 26th 1945 for skillful command of the 335th Rifle Division (25th Army, 1st Far-Eastern Front) during the liberation of Manchuria and Korea from the Japanese. Based on the citation, during a lightning-fast offensive, which started on August 9th 1945 and ended on Sept. 12th, Volkov's troops liberated the city of Hun'chun', taking 5000 POW's. Then they took 9200 POW's during fighting in the Kundzio area, and another 28000 POW's in the Hejdzio area – a whopping total of 42200 POW's within one month of operation! Rare award from the Japan/South Asia theater.

Полковник Волков, командуя своей 335-й стрелковой дивизией (25-я армия, ДВ фронт), и умело руководя и взаимодействуя всеми частями дивизии, сумел разгромить вражеские войска и овладел городом Хуньчунь. 



ШКЛОВ. Оккупирован 12 июля 1941 г. Освобожден 27 июня 1944 г. войсками 2 БФ в ходе Могилевской операции. Приказом ВГК соединениям и частям, отличившимся при форсировании Днепра и овладении городами Могилев, Шклов, Быхов, присвоены наименования Верхнеднепровских и Могилевских. Наименование Верхнеднепровских присвоено: 31 отд. гв. габр (полковник Зябликов Сергей Васильевич),.... Заслуживает особого интереса факт выбора награды, врученной польскому военнослужащему. Прототип ордена гетман Богдан Хмельницкий в польской истории сыграл совсем не положительную роль - восстание, которое он возглавил в 1648г., в конечном итоге привело к закату золотой эры польско-литовского могущества, и вообще всю свою жизнь он посвятил борьбе за независимость от Польши. Видимо поэтому данный орден не имеет следов ношения...

As stated on the 'mondvor' website, some orders were observed with the rivets just marked, but not actually used, and some orders were observed with the rivets' tops polished off (although, the markings were still visible). *Exceedingly Rare.*
